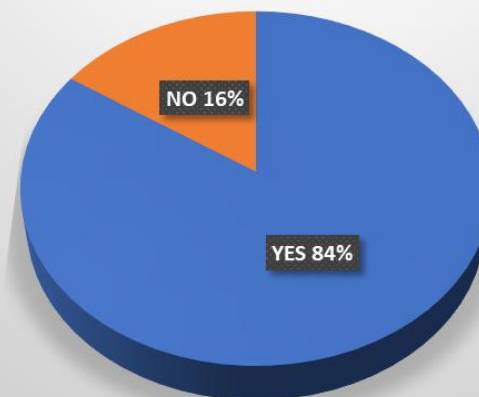

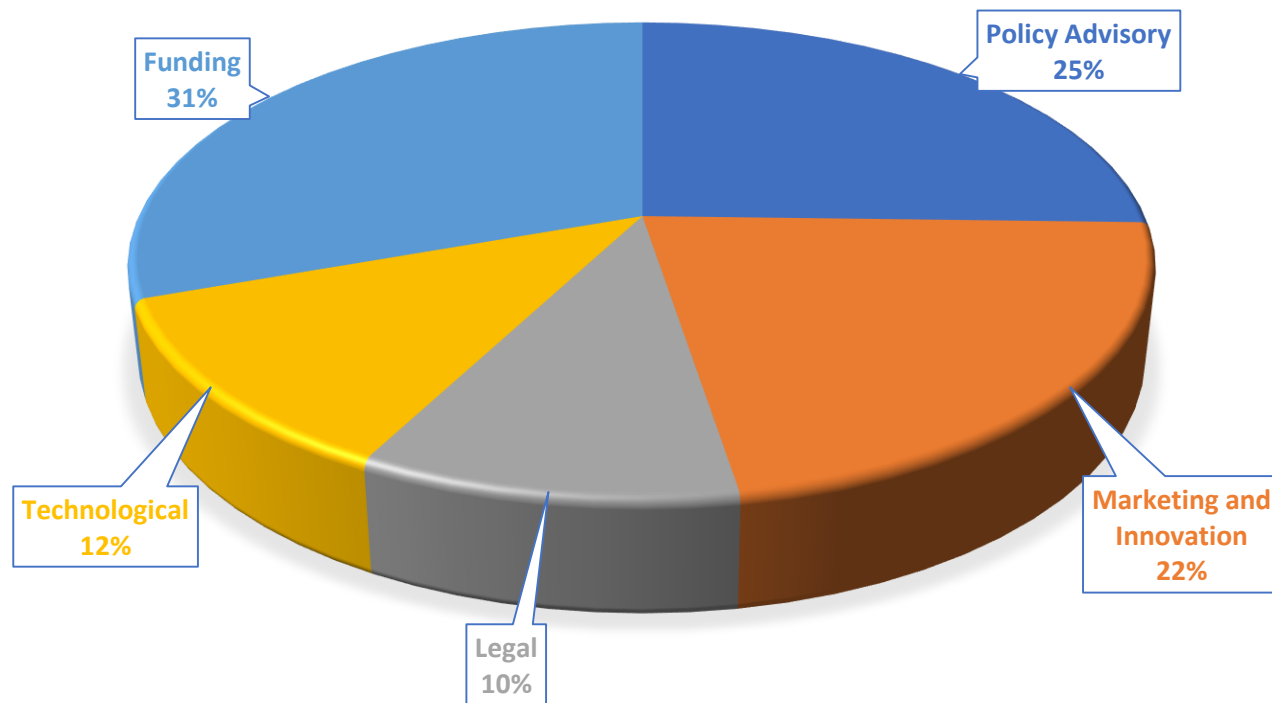

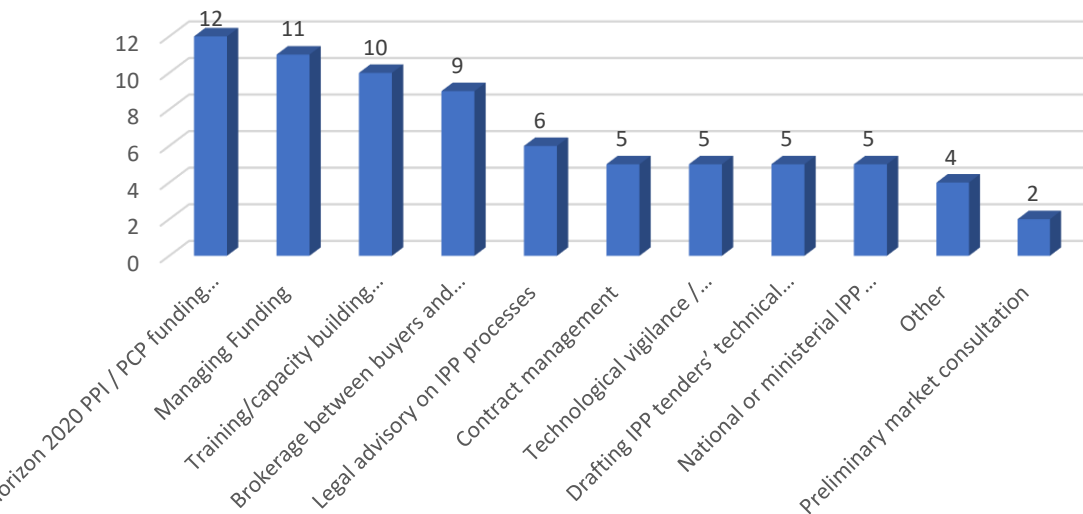
Is your organization involved in any activity directly or indirectly promoting Innovation Public Procurement?

IPP services



Most popular IPP services:

1. H2020 IPP NCP
2. Managing funding
3. Training / Capacity building
4. Brokerage between buyers and suppliers

➔ At least **50 %** of respondent entities offer IPP services

➔ **63 %** of respondents offer services on a **permanent basis**
37 % provide services on a **temporary basis**

1. **Funding, Policy advisory** and **Marketing and Innovation** are the internal competences most mobilized for IPP activities, (not so much technological or legal competences as they require a high level of technical expertise).
2. Promotion of H2020 funding opportunities for IPP (**H2020 NCP activity**), **training and capacity building** on IPP, **brokerage** activities between buyers and suppliers and the **managing of funding** (budgets) for IPP activities are the IPP services most put in place by respondents in contrast with others that require a higher level of technical expertise, e.g; legal advisory, drafting of contracts and tenders, technology vigilance, etc.
3. There are more agencies providing IPP services on a permanent basis than agencies providing services on a temporary basis
4. In terms of profile of entities providing these IPP services, we can conclude that National Innovation Agencies are the most prominent in providing IPP services rather than the regional ones.
